
Bespoke Unit's Key Wholecut Facts

- Mass-produced wholecuts have one seam at the heel counter, bespoke ones have none
 - Often more expensive than regular oxfords due to the skill needed to manufacture



What Makes It A Wholecut?


• A wholecut shoe is an oxford whose upper is made from just one piece of leather
