What Makes It A Driving Loafer?

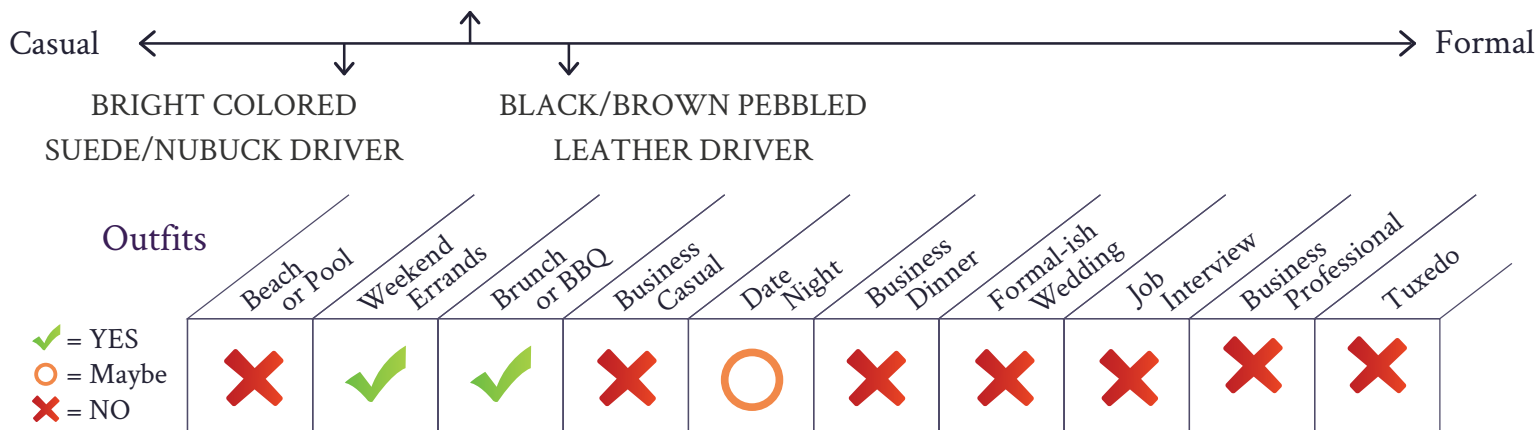
- A driver has rubber nubs on the sole and heel counter that help you grip a car's pedals
