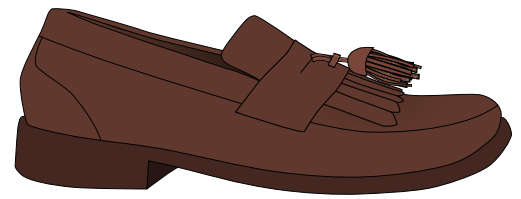

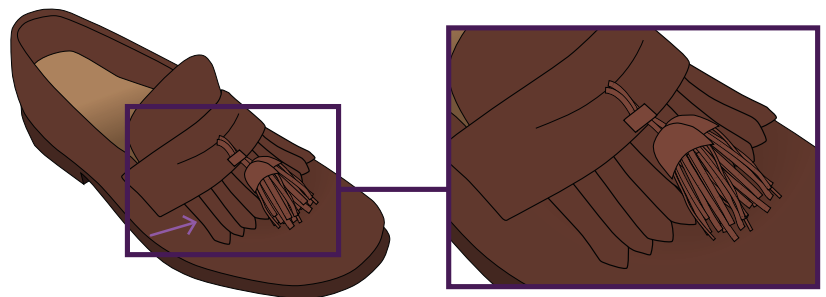
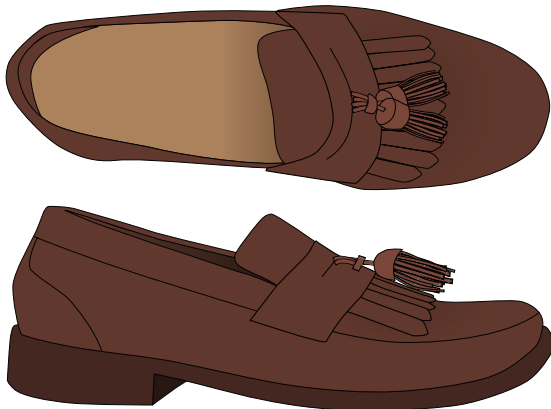


Bespoke Unit's Key Kiltie Shoe Facts

- Also known as a "golfing brogue," it comes from Scotland
- Refers to any shoe with a decorative fringe on the instep

What Makes It A Kiltie?

- A kiltie is a shoe that has decorative leather fringe covering the instep and is available in tassel, and buckle versions
