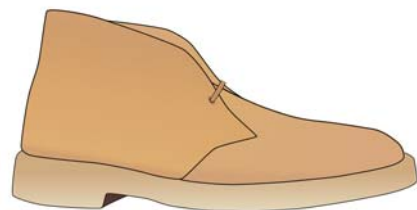


# Bespoke Unit's Guide To The Desert Boot

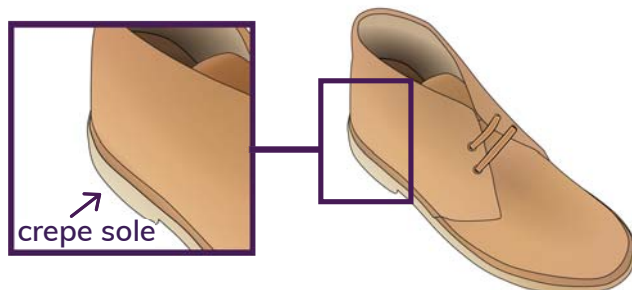


## Bespoke Unit's Key Desert Boot Facts

- A crepe-sole chukka boot, it's very casual and looks great with jeans and chinos

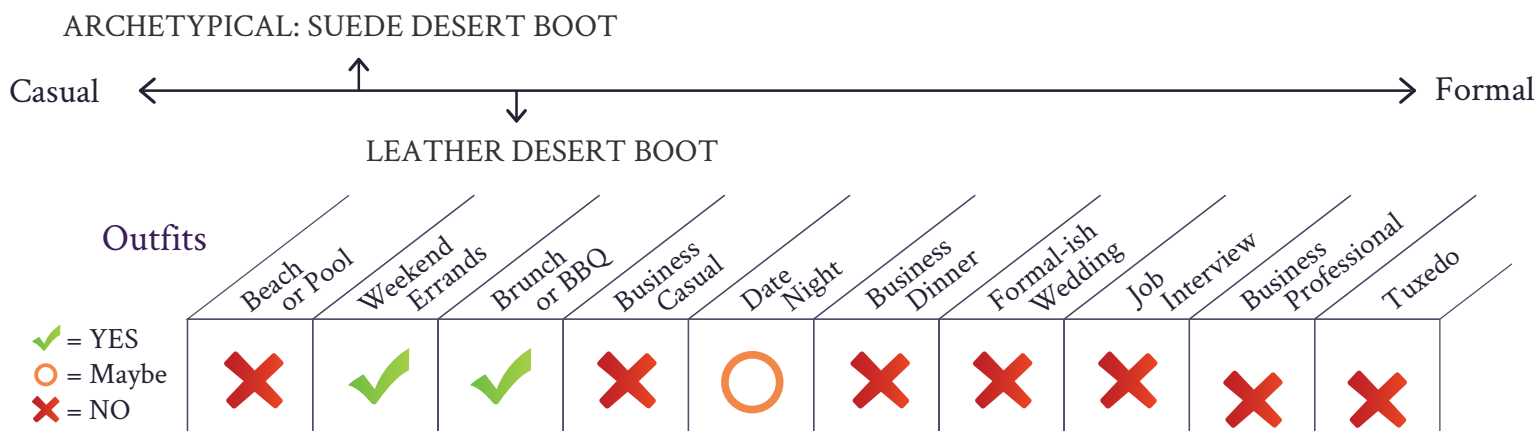
## What Makes It A Desert Boot?

- A desert boot is an ankle-height lace-up boot with a crepe sole, which looks and feels like a slightly sticky stucco.



## Desert Boot Style Guide

Below is our "formality slider" for the desert boot and its casual and dress variations



- Desert boots work well for men with wider feet as their last is wider
- These are very casual boots. Wear with jeans and chinos, not dress trousers or suits
