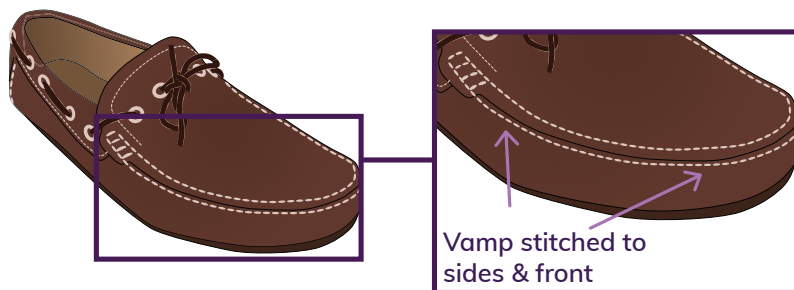


Bespoke Unit's Key Moccasin Facts

- Invented by Native Americans, moccasin have been in use for hundreds of years
- Traditionally a soft shoe made from one piece of leather, "moccasin construction" refers to how a shoe's upper is made & there are multiple variations ranging from drivers to slippers

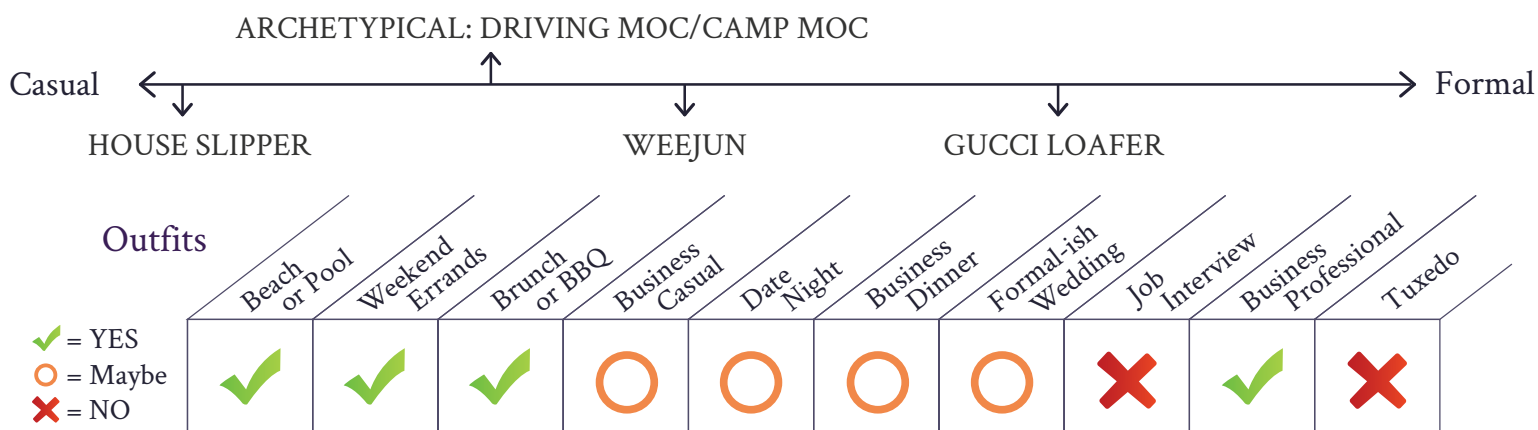
What Makes It A Moccasin?

- A moccasin is any shoe whose upper has sole and sides made from one piece of leather. It may be sewn together as one piece or there may be a second piece of leather acting as the vamp



Moccasin Style Guide

Below is our "formality slider" for the moccasin and its casual and formal variations



- Moccasin styles vary greatly and are thus appropriate any time of year depending on the specific style
- Can be worn as casually as a house slipper and as formally as a worsted suit
