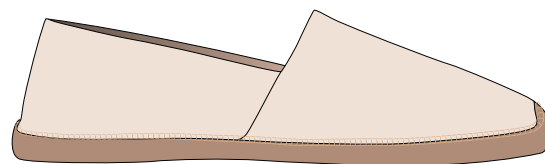


Bespoke Unit's Guide To The Men's Espadrille

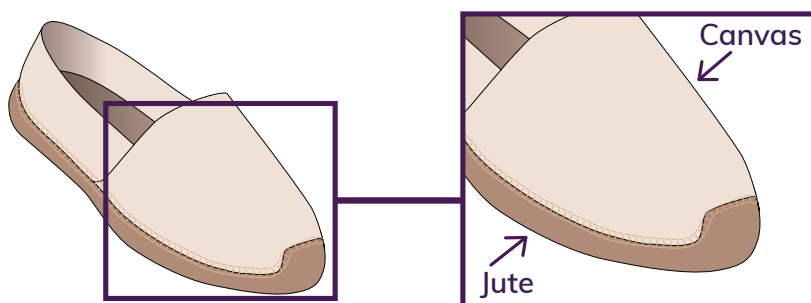
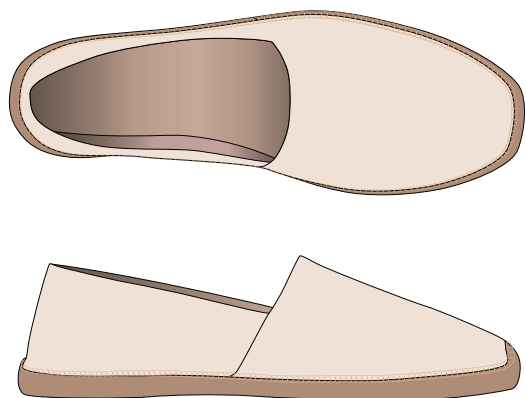


Bespoke Unit's Key Espadrille Facts

- Their use dates back to the 14th century in the Pyrenees region of Europe
- The shoe's name is derivative of the rope originally used for its sole, *esparto*

What Makes It An Espadrille?

- An espadrille is a shoe with a canvas (but sometimes leather or suede) upper and a sole made of cork and some type of rope, typically jute
