

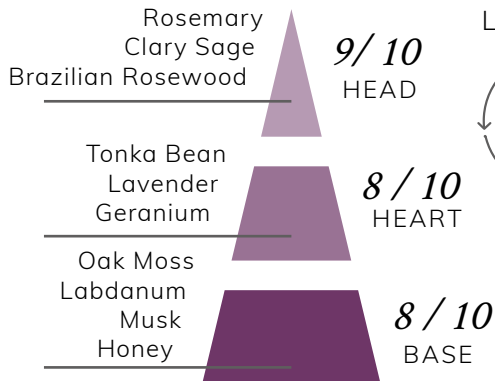
### PACO RABANNE - POUR HOMME - EST. 1973
