

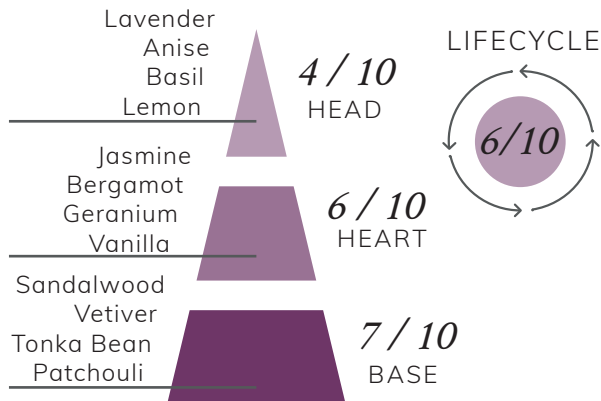
### BRUT PARFUMS PRESTIGE - ORIGINAL - EST. 1964

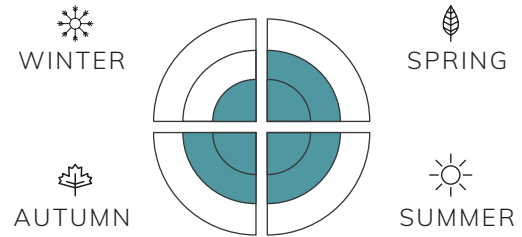

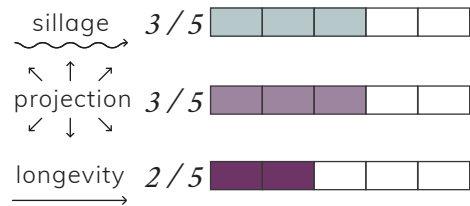

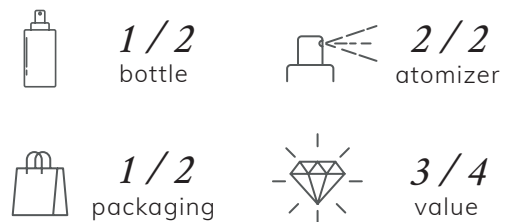
