

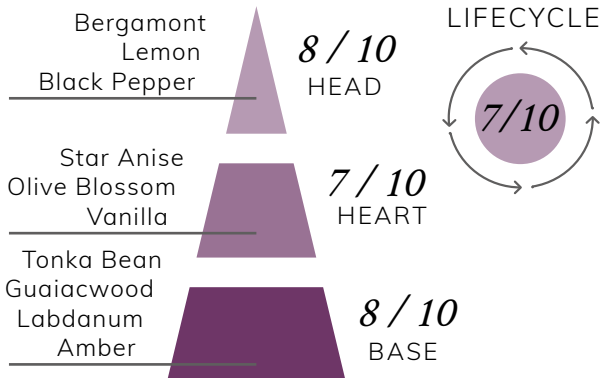
GIORGIO ARMANI - ARMANI CODE - EST. 2004

Armani Code opens with a deep, heady citrus burst consisting of sweet bergamot and tangy lemon. Black peppers create substance as Code transitions to a gourmand heart of spicy anise, fresh olive blossom and creamy vanilla. Powdery notes of guaiacwood and amber emerge, which create a tobacco accord. Meanwhile warm tonka bean and labdanum interact to develop a musky leather accord.

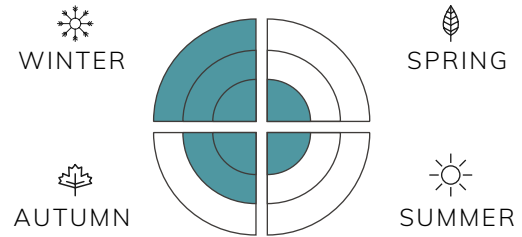

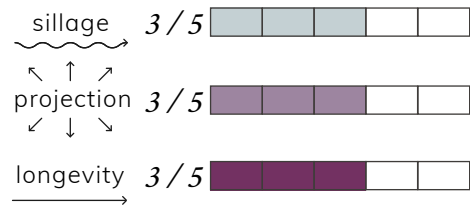

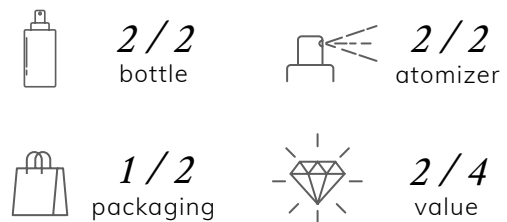
