

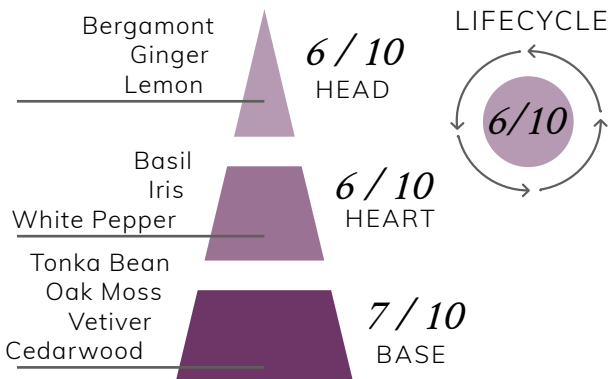
YVES SAINT LAURENT - L'HOMME - EST. 2006

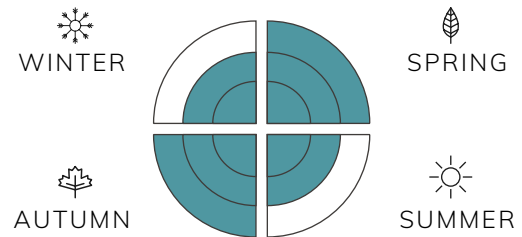

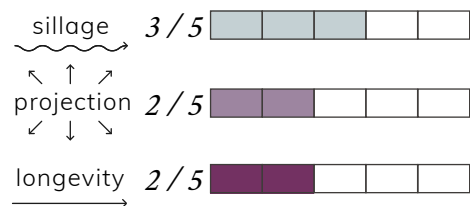

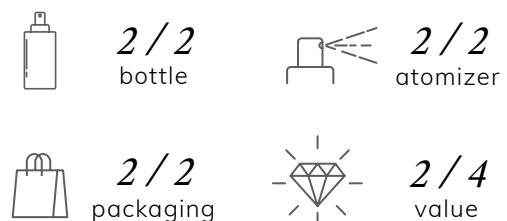
