

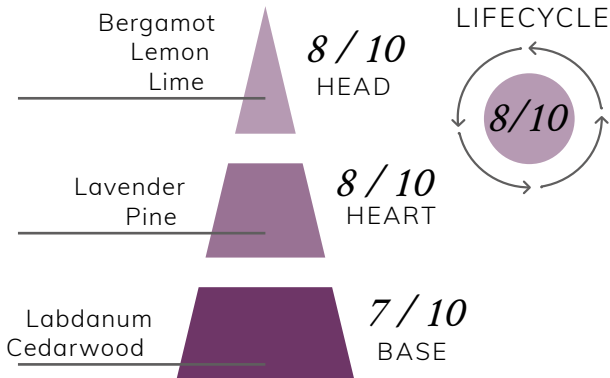
PENHALIGON'S - BLENHEIM BOUQUET - EST. 1902

Blenheim Bouquet opens on a citrus blast that consists of sharp lemon and lime alongside softer bergamot. Shortly after, fragrant lavender kicks in and is accompanied by crisp notes of pine. Eventually, Blenheim Bouquet settles on a musky labdanum and cedarwood base with latent notes of citrus and the aforementioned pine.
