

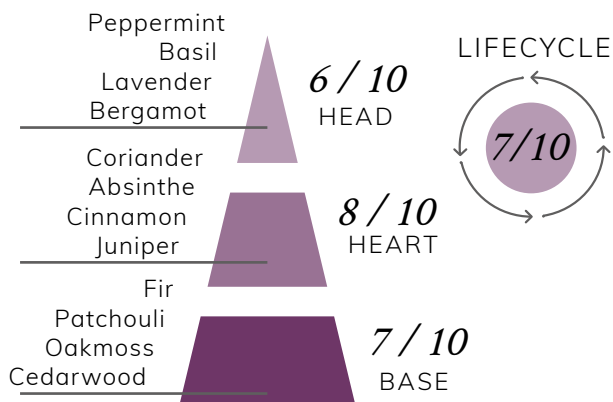
GUY LAROCHE - DRAKKAR NOIR - EST. 1982
