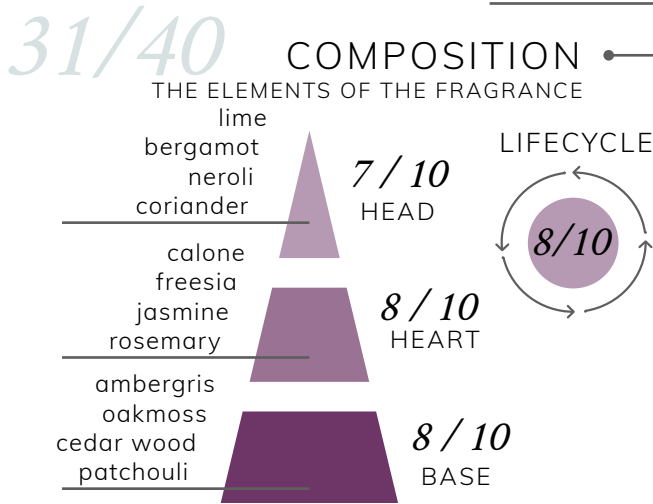


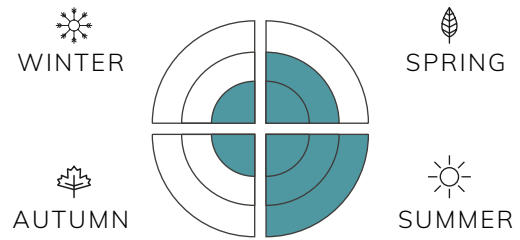
GIORGIO ARMANI - ACQUA DI GIÒ - EST. 1996

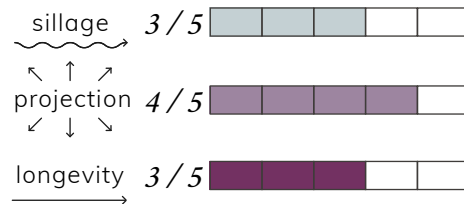

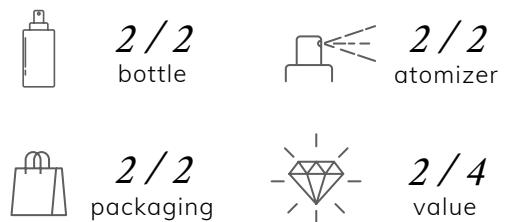
